# Entertainment Books

## How much can we raise from selling Entertainment Books?

The books sell for \$60 and the club gets \$12 from each sale. The more books you sell, the more money you stand to make!

No! The Entertainment Book people handle all the deliveries and shipping, so you don't have to touch a book (unless you buy one yourself of course).
